

Fixing Max Connections to PostgreSQL

You may need to increase the maximum connections if you receive an error message similar to the following:

- Failed to connect to back-end database "TranDb"
FATAL: remaining connection slots are reserved for non-replication superuser connections
- (0) SQL Error! SQLSTATE = 53300 Native err = 210 msg = FATAL: remaining connection slots are reserved for non-replication superuser connections
- (1) SQL Error! SQLSTATE = IM006 Native err = 0 msg = [Microsoft][ODBC Driver Manager] Driver's SQLSetConnectAttr failed
- Details:
Unable to connect to database using connection string:
UID=jitterbit;PWD=<REMOVED>;SERVER=127.0.0.1;DRIVER={PostgreSQL ODBC Driver(UNICODE)};DATABASE=TranDb;Port=5432;!

In order to increase your maximum connections in PostgreSQL, set the **max_connections = 200** in the file C:\Program Files (x86)\PostgreSQL\9.0\data\postgresql.conf if you are on windows.
